

RIDE LEADER PRE-RIDE BRIEFING

- * Welcome riders and introduce yourself
- * Discuss safety reminders:

RIDE SMART— RIDE ACCIDENT FREE

STAY ALERT! — Pay attention to everything around you, including other riders, cars, road conditions, and your own physical status.

MAINTAIN YOUR LINE — Be predictable to other riders and cars. Always assume riders are behind you or about to pass.

ACCIDENTS — Road hazards, collisions with other riders, and loss of control on downhills are often the cause of accidents.

RESPECT — Please respect your fellow riders, the rules of the road, and the motorists we share them with.

TALK — Hand signals and calling out hazards and intentions are essential for group riding. First communicate, then move.

- * Offer details about your ride and WCC rides in general:
 - a. State name of ride, pace, mileage, and any known road hazards
 - b. State regroup frequency, rest/lunch stops, and what riders should expect from leader (do you have sweep rider, do you stop for mechanical problems, etc.)
 - c. Ask riders who leave the ride to tell the leader or sweep
 - d. Identify new members and reinforce safety message, as appropriate
 - e. Welcome non-members and encourage them to get info about joining WCC
 - f. Remind riders to be helpful to and responsible for each other
 - g. Make certain everyone is wearing a helmet and has signed the waiver form
 - h. Have riders introduce themselves to each other
 - i. Finish with reminder to ride **SMART**
